No 21 1 The Company of Regulars  
under St Field will resume its position  
as the garrison to Fort Niagara

2d on the arrival of St Field  
with his command Capt Worrier will  
march his company of N York Volunteers to this  
place

3d Capt Tutbill commanding  
N York Volunteers now stationed at the  
village of Niagara falls will on the receipt of this  
order immediately march his command to  
this place engaging one wagon or sleigh

to convey the company baggage

4th The Asst Quarter Master Capt Thomas  
will make arrangements for the transportation  
of the regulars hence to Fort Niagara and  
of Capt Worriers Company from the latter  
to this place
